WORLD'S LARGEST SINGLE SITE SOLAR PLANT IN INDIA

Adani owns and operates the world's largest single-site solar plant in Tamil Nadu, India, which uses the latest solar technology to maximise energy output, with a generating capacity of 650MW.

Spread over an area of 2,500 acres (10km2), it's an important part of Adani's portfolio of renewable energy plants with capacity of over 650MW.



WORLD CLASS SOLAR PANEL MANUFACTURING

Adani also own and operate a world class solar panel manufacturing plant in Mundra, Gujarat and produce 1.2GW of panels every year, including hi-tech solar PV cells and modules using advanced Multi, Mono PERC and Bifacial cell technology.

Adani aims to become a fully-integrated solar PV manufacturer with a capacity of 3GW, producing the entire value chain from polysilicon to modules all under one roof, by 2020.
