Executive Summary

Welcome to the 2022 Development Status Report for Toowoomba, produced by Toowoomba and Surat Basin Enterprise (TSBE).

The Development Status Report is updated biannually to equip readers with knowledge including costs and locations for known developments in the Toowoomba region. It is through providing this record that TSBE hopes to encourage further investment while also providing businesses with the relevant information to make sound business decisions.

The 2022 report only lists developments valued at more than \$1 million. The projects compiled within this report have been categorised as per the following **(\$B**):

•	Projects Underway	\$4.3 billion
•	Projects Approved and Awaiting Commencement	\$10.2 billion
•	Projects Proposed	\$4.3 billion

The key findings of this report highlights the current level of investment in Toowoomba is **\$18.8 billion.** This is an increase on the 2020 report of \$5.7 billion and highlights the confidence that both the private and public sector have in the future of Toowoomba.

While COVID-19 brought a level of uncertainty, a number of major projects like the Qantas Group Pilot Academy (\$40 million) and the Regional Trade Distribution Centre (\$10 million) were completed during this time. The growth of the renewables industry was also evident over the past 12 months with the construction of the Yarranlea Solar project (\$200 million) at Pittsworth with more energy infrastructure planned.

Possibly the most anticipated project in this report is Inland Rail, with the Border to Gowrie section (\$2 billion) and the Toowoomba to Kagaru Sections PPP (\$3.55 billion). This initiative providing rail freight between Melbourne and Brisbane will transform the region's transport and logistics capability and businesses are now preparing for the construction phase which is set to deliver approximately 2,000 local jobs over five years.

Renewable energy will continue to contribute to the large pipeline of projects in the region. The MacIntyre Wind Farm is anticipated to start construction this year with a construction duration of 18-24 months and will bring significant economic activity across the Toowoomba Regional Council areas with an investment around \$2 billion. There is another wind farm nearing final stages of investment decision in the Toowoomba region, Captains Mountain Wind Farm near Millmerran. This project will have an expected capacity of up to 380MW and an estimated investment of around \$700 million. Also included in our diversity of energy is the region's first proposed pumped hydro project with a estimated construction cost of \$980 million and the proposed Bulli Creek Solar Farm which is expected to generate in excess 2000MW, making it one of Australia's largest solar farms.

Other significant projects currently underway include Asterion's medicinal cannabis facility (\$450 million), Interlink SQ at Charlton (\$235 million) and the upgrade of Cooby Dam, Cressbrook Dam Spillway (\$138 million). This report also highlights the enormous economic benefit of the proposed Toowoomba Hospital Redevelopment (\$1.6 billion).

The stability and diversity of the Toowoomba economy is one of the key drivers attracting investors to the region. It's also a wonderful place to live and the TSBE team is committed to helping local industry continue to build a strong and sustainable economy.
