

KEY WIND FARM STATISTICS

The worldwide push for renewable energy sources, lower power prices and the reduction of carbon-emitting fossil fuels is the driving force behind Australia's expansion in wind farm developments. Most states and territories have independently legislated their own Renewable Energy Targets (RETs) and many companies are seeking to source cheaper and lower impact electricity, which means the construction of wind farms is happening all around the nation. In Queensland there are currently 50 large-scale renewable energy projects (operating under construction or financially committed). This represents \$10.7 billion of investment, 7,900 jobs, 5,774 megawatts of clean energy and more than 13.8 million tonnes of avoided emissions each year (current as at 1 January, 2022).

As of February, 2022, there are 34 large-scale power projects under development in the TSBE local government areas with a total capacity of almost 11GW. Around 98% of these projects are clean energy; wind, solar or battery. This capacity represents almost 30% of all projects under development in Queensland and 7% of all projects National Energy Market (NEM) wide. As wind farm numbers increase, it is anticipated that wind energy will capture a greater share of the total renewable energy target.

There are two phases in the life of a wind farm: construction and operation. The wind farm construction sector provides engineering, procurement and construction services for wind power generation projects. These are "major projects" and attract highly sophisticated operators who employ large numbers of skilled workers. IBISWorld has provided us with the following statistics on the industry to give an idea of scale and scope in Australia and in Queensland. No matter where wind farms are being constructed, they bring economic opportunities for local businesses. Understanding the industry and how to leverage these opportunities is key for regional communities.

During the period 2022-2027 the windfarm sector is forecast to undergo a;

- 5.9% Annual growth of major companies specialising in the Wind Farm sector
- 12.9% Annual growth of jobs in the sector
- 15.8% Annual growth in wages for workers in the sector
- Annual growth of \$1.3 billion in revenue

RENEWABLE ENERGY ZONES - REZ

A Renewable Energy Zone (REZ) is an area with high quality renewable resources like wind and solar that can be developed in a coordinated way with strong transmission lines to deliver the electricity to where it is needed.

The Queensland renewable energy sector has grown rapidly since 2015. This investment boom has delivered employment and infrastructure outcomes into mostly regional areas of Queensland. However, new challenges have emerged for renewable developers in managing risks like congestion and other grid constraints.

Coordinated development means multiple generators can be connected in a cost-effective way. This supports an optimal electricity generation mix in Queensland that complements existing and emerging industries and benefits local communities.

The Southern REZ covers areas identified by the *Australian Energy Market Operator* as having good quality renewable resources and other characteristics suitable for renewable energy development. In these areas we will:

- Undertake strategic network investments
- · Streamline the development of new renewable energy projects
- Work to match new and existing industrial energy demand with our cheap, clean, renewable energy.

How Local Communities Benefit


Development of Queensland REZ (QREZ) will deliver investment into Queensland's regional economies, driving employment, energy and infrastructure outcomes. Long-term development of QREZ is focused on delivering lasting community benefits on the path to 50% renewable energy by 2030.

The local benefits and social outcomes will be in two main areas: local content participation and community benefits from social licence activities.

The ultimate number of jobs will be dependent on the design and scale of the renewable projects developed. Many indirect local jobs are expected to flow through to communities as businesses are called upon to support both the initial construction phase and ongoing project needs. This could include greater local content participation in supply chains and manufacturing of renewable energy components.

WAMBO WIND FARM

The Wambo Wind Farm (Project) is a proposed wind energy development located near Jandowae in the Western Downs region of Queensland. The Project, the first stage of which is due for completion in 2024, will feature up to 110 turbines contributing approximately 500MW of renewable energy to the national electricity grid. The site will also include a 50MW/200MWh battery storage and associated infrastructure. The Project will help the Queensland Government reach its renewable energy generation target of 50 per cent by 2030 as the state transitions to a low carbon emissions future.

Why Wambo

Located in the heart of Australia's energy capital on the Western Downs, the Wambo Wind Farm project is located approximately 200km north west of Brisbane and 20km north east of the town of Jandowae. The area has been identified for its excellent wind resources, attractive grid connectivity and low environmental impact.

Who We Are - The Developers

The Wambo Wind Farm was conceived and explored by Renewable Energy Partners (REP) in mid-2018. In late 2018 and 2019, REP secured a number of landowners to participate in the project. In 2019 REP and Cubico Sustainable Investments agreed to co-develop the Project with the intent that Cubico would be the long-term owner and operator of the Wambo Wind Farm.

Cubico Sustainable Investments

Founded in May 2015, Cubico Sustainable Investments is one of the world's largest privately-owned renewable energy companies. It is backed by the resources of Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan, Canada's largest single-profession pension plan, and PSP Investments, one of Canada's largest pension investment managers. Cubico's global portfolio in 12 countries has an installed gross capacity of 3GW, with nearly 2GW in construction and its development pipeline. Cubico is headquartered in London and has offices in São Paulo and Brazil, Greece, Milan, US, Mexico, Spain, France, Australia, Uruguay and Colombia.

Renewable Energy Partners

REP brings together a team of highly motivated professionals with over 80 years of combined experience to originate and develop large-scale renewable energy projects in Australia. Other current REP projects include the 250MW Hopeland Solar Farm, the 500MW Eungella Wind Farm and the 1.4GW+/11GWhr+ Bowen Pumped Hydroelectric Scheme. REP also have a number of other renewable energy projects totaling over 3GW of generation in various stages of development.

When fully operational, the Wambo Wind Farm will produce enough clean energy to

power approximately 170,500 houses annually



Stages

Wambo Wind Farm project will be built in two stages:



Stage One of the Project will deliver around 250MW of renewable wind energy to the national electricity grid. It will see the construction of approximately 42 turbines.

Stage Two of the Project is contingent on the outcome of feasibility studies and could see up to approximately 40 turbines and 250MW of renewable energy being generated.

WELCOME TO JANDOWAE

Location

Jandowae district covers 254km² of the picturesque Western Downs region in southern Queensland. From the air, it is a patchwork of colour with fields of wheat, barley, sorghum, and sunflowers surrounded by mountain ranges. It sits within the Indigenous country of Barunggam, the traditional lands of the Barunggam people.

Getting There

By road: 260km from Brisbane, 140km from Toowoomba and 48km from Dalby.

By air: Fly into Brisbane or Toowoomba Wellcamp Airports and then drive to Jandowae. The nearest aerodromes for smaller aircraft are at Dalby and Chinchilla.

Weather

Temperatures range from around 18 to 32 degrees Celsius in summer and 0 to 20 degrees Celsius in winter.

Main Industries

The Western Downs is known as the "Energy Capital of Australia" with significant investment in mining and renewable energy industries. However, the local economy is underpinned by agriculture, especially beef, with 42% of Australia's feedlots within 200km of Dalby. Service industries for the energy and agricultural sectors provide manufacturing and fabrication, engineering and supplies.

Community

Jandowae's tight-knit community of around 1,200 people is kept busy creating a happy, healthy and interesting life for its residents.

Liveability

Housing

Affordability in the Western Downs is one of its key attractions for workers and families. According to www.realestate.com the median house price in Jandowae is around \$130,000.

Health

As part of Queensland Health's Western Cluster, Jandowae Hospital offers medical, emergency, outpatients and palliative care. It has a child health clinic and a range of visiting allied health services.

Services

Help is at hand with government services on your doorstep: Queensland Government Agents, police station, fire brigade, SES, ambulance service, post office and community services such as Meals on Wheels.

Employment

The Western Downs region is seeking skilled workers across a variety of industries including mining and energy, agriculture, manufacturing, health and labour.

Education

Families have access to day care, preschool, primary and high school to Year 10.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR LOCAL BUSINESS

Wambo Wind Farm is focused on supporting the Western Downs by employing local labour, engaging local businesses and sourcing local supplies wherever possible. Wind farms are labour intensive during construction. Wambo Wind Farm will require around 200 workers during this phase. Once the project is operational, staffing is streamlined and there will be around 20 equivalent full-time staff required to maintain and manage the Wambo site.

1. Minimum Requirements

The Major Project sector has some very specific minimum requirements when it comes to working with local business including:

- Pre-qualification when requested
- · Quality a system accreditation
- Financial capability and all necessary insurances
- · Project readiness or evidence of track record
- WHS&E Management Plan
- Tendering credentials

2. Pre-requisite, Pre-Qualification and Vendor Registration

A contractor that works directly for the OEM (original equipment manufacturer) will be familiar with pre-requisite requirements regarding high risk, highly technical/high value items or operations and maintenance service requirements. It is for this reason that OEMs typically recruit as few contractors as possible. In fact, they often "self-perform" as much of the wind farm requirement as possible thereby carrying the most risk.

Local Business Opportunity

The balance of plant contractor will likely be a specialist in civil/earthworks or electrical or both and as such have pre-requisites regarding pre-qualifications to work with them.

3. Typical Contracting Model

The typical model for contracting on a wind farm involves the developer selecting an original equipment manufacturer (OEM) for the purposes of securing key equipment. The OEM will partner with a balance of plant contractor who will undertake civil site preparation and electrical.

Any specialist, highly technical or high-risk capability such as cranage, transport, high voltage electrification, controls and SCADA would likely fall to the Tier One OEM contractor. A local company would need depth of capability and sophistication to pre-qualify and work with a Tier One.

A significant site contractor working for the balance of plant contractor may recruit subcontractors. This is often an ideal opportunity for local firms to supply products and services such as water cartage, earthmoving equipment, labour hire and so on.

The Powerlink Story

The Wambo Wind Farm developer has engaged Powerlink for a significant scope of critical work. This is to establish any transmission and distribution assets such as construction of electricity towers, high voltage lines, transformers, substations and control rooms for the Wind Farm.

The specialist work is carried out by Powerlink's own staff or subcontractors registered and pre-qualified with Powerlink to work on electrified sites. These same subcontractors can maintain the electrical assets once operational (if Powerlink does not).

The control rooms on the Wind Farm site involve SCADA systems for automation and monitoring. These can be carried out by local specialist firms. Each system is terminated to one major control centre, also on site, which houses the O&M staff and monitors for complete visibility over the performance of the facility.

Further opportunities for local business and local civil contractors will be required for site preparation including earthworks on concrete pads for Powerlink equipment.

LOCAL SUCCESS STORIES

Major projects provide many opportunities for local businesses. Not only can they be lucrative but they can also help businesses to grow, fine-tune processes, hone skills and gain valuable experience for future projects. We asked LCR Transport and Newlands Developments to share some thoughts on how working with major wind farm projects has benefitted them.

LCR Group Pty Ltd

LCR Group is a broad-spectrum mining and industrial services company with a reputation for getting the job done safely and efficiently. We provide leading innovative lift and shift materials handling solutions throughout Australia and PNG.

Which organisation contracted you to work on their wind farm project?

LCR has worked on five wind farms, now complete, including the Coopers Gap Wind Farm which is owned by Powering Australian Renewables. The company's most recent project was with General Electric (GE) www.ge.com.

What was the scope of your involvement?

Oversize logistics and crane work.

How many of your staff were onsite and for how long?

We had around 25 staff for 18 months.

What has your involvement in this project meant for your business overall?

This project was a great stepping-stone in the evolution of the LCR/Qube renewable energy division. The project was perfect for our business as it was located in our back yard. It has provided us with a greater understanding of LCR's capabilities in the industry. We were also able to make a substantial investment in equipment for heavy haulage.



Newlands Group

Newlands delivers design and construction for civil, commercial and industrial infrastructure projects. They are ideas people and problem solvers across a wide range of engineering services.

Which organisation contracted you to work on their wind farm project?

Initially Newlands was contracted for early works by the project owner at Coopers Gap Wind Farm. We were then contacted by Catcon, the main contractor on site, for the construction of the Powerlink pad and associated access road and drainage works. At the completion of the project General Electric, the OEM, made contact directly to undertake additional post completion works and maintenance.

What was the scope of your involvement?

- Bulk earthworks for creation of main sub-station pad, access roads and crane pads
- Main road works including intersection upgrades on site and major intersection upgrades between Toowoomba and site to allow for tower and turbine delivery
- Drainage works
- Excavating and backfilling electrical trenches
- General plant and labour hire
- Engineering design
- Removal of crane pads and reinstatement works in accordance with the environmental requirements

How many of your staff were onsite and for how long?

- 20 30 construction staff during six months of construction
- 5 10 early works and rehabilitation stage for 24 months

What has your involvement in this project meant for your business overall?

By undertaking wind farm works, Newlands has been able to gain more experience in the installation of wind energy and broaden our horizons to undertake work with other renewable energy sources such as solar energy. It has also allowed the company to be able to expose smaller local companies that were subcontracted to expand their experience by working on larger scale projects and renewable projects as our subcontractors.





ANALYSIS

Methodology

The methodology used for this report and assessment of local content opportunities ties to a market sounding exercise of local businesses interested in wind farm construction and development. The mapping tool used to generate this information was assembled through the work of TSBE, OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer), Balance of Plant contractors and the Wambo Wind Farm development team at Cubico Sustainable Investments. The teams collaborated to extract the project phases of development from feasibility to commissioning and also highlight areas available for local content participation. They have also acknowledged specialist areas that will not be available for local content such as proprietary equipment or services.

Capability

From a review of the participants in the mapping exercise, there are several experienced and highly capable subcontractors in the group. They bring experience from other wind farm projects in Queensland and interstate including Victoria and South Australia. It is worth noting that this level of expertise could be significant in terms of local content success.

Strengths - Civil Construction and Earthwork

Surat Basin's civil contracting businesses have a wealth of experience and background in the construction and renewable energy sector. Wind farm developments begin as civil construction sites until the electrical infrastructure is commissioned. This means that many of the disciplines regarding site establishment (site construction, earthmoving, materials, trenching, access roads, local government roads, earthworks and drainage) can be covered by capable local firms. These firms would be encouraged to compete for the work.

Strengths and Opportunity - Electrical

The Surat Basin region is home to several highly-skilled commercial electricians with the skills to work in the industrial sphere related to wind farm construction. In terms of renewable development, these commercial electricians would be working with specialist wind farm balance of plant contractors with whom they may not be familiar.

Barriers to entry for local businesses may be in the area of pre-qualification and vendor management requirements for medium voltage electrical specialists.

Regarding electrical opportunities from the high-voltage side, the region's existing sub-contractors for companies such as Powerlink, Ergon and Urban Utilites will be able to compete for work in the wind farm sector. Powerlink already has a considerable scope of work for the Wambo Wind Farm including high voltage connection following construction and once electrical connection preparation is complete. There is also opportunity for subcontractors to take on work not carried out by Powerlink's own workforce.

Strengths and Opportunity - Skills

The region's electrical firms bring a depth of experience and capability in other industrial sectors such as gas, coal and power stations. These companies have a large well-trained workforce established through quality apprenticeship schemes. The opportunity for employment does have a risk factor: the wind farm may require a large cohort of skilled workers over an extended period (24 months, depending on size of project) which may take local firms away from their traditional customer base. It is hoped that at the decision making level, local employers would see that the benefits of working in the renewables industry, as an emerging sector for Queensland, outweigh any inconveniences.

Threat - External Bias

Local expertise (in major projects) can easily be misunderstood or lost on major project proponents. This is due to an overlay effect where a company's previous project experience in another region is assumed incorrectly. This is especially prevalent in areas relating to site establishment, site assessment, environmental & engineering consultancy and management, workforce knowledge and understanding, and also local community engagement.

Major projects contributing funds to community activities, also need to ensure committed local spend in the region either through hiring staff, booking accommodation and meals, and establishing accounts at service stations. These service providers should be sought from towns closest to the project with reporting parameters on local spend set to record this aspect of economic contribution made by the project.

OTHER REPORT CATEGORIES

Positivity – Innovation in equipment and technology from a new emerging sector

Wambo Wind Farm will capture the attention of elite, international companies General Electric, Siemens Gamesa, Vestas and Goldwind. Equipment used on the Wambo Wind Farm will feature cutting edge design and efficiency to power communities of the future. The community Is set to be the recipient of world-class technologies and the Western Downs region stands to benefit by embracing and leveraging opportunities offered by OEMs.

Opportunity

The Surat Basin is home to innovative and historical entrepreneurial enterprises and businesses. These larger international businesses have the opportunity to leverage and grow innovation utilizing this innovative supply chain and potentially grow these local business into global entities. These businesses, if given the opportunity to present solution based procurement in a correct and timely format will foster innovation and leave a lasting legacy.

Wind farm development is often accompanied by large battery energy storage systems or BESS. BESS is used to stabilize and moderate the electrical grid from the influx of power produced by large generating projects like wind farms or solar farms. This energy can be stored when not required and then used beneficially when it is in high demand. This in turn reduces the requirement of traditional carbon-intensive power generation such as coal, gas and steam turbine power stations.

The REZ - Queensland Renewable Energy Zones

The Southern Queensland renewable energy zone (QREZ) represents a geographic area of existing energy assets in the form of power stations, coal mines, electrical transmission, electrical distribution, solar and wind farms. The Queensland Government is assessing the expansion of QREZ to promote further development and ensure continued jobs growth in regional Queensland. A significant focus has been placed on ensuring the flow of local benefits from the state government's commitment to forward major projects. It is vital to facilitate local benefit opportunities at the local level throughout the whole supply chain, fully understand the regional opportunity and maximize these opportunities.

Training and Skilling to Liveability

Training providers in the Western Downs region have depth and experience in skilling the construction and industrial workforce. This has occurred through the steady transition of oil and gas development, coal seam gas development, coal mine and power station development, as well as solar farm and now wind farm development. Transition requirements have been identified by government and industry and are supported through funding initiatives. As such, workers with an interest in upskilling from their existing trade should be able to find avenues to move into the renewable arena. Moreover, they should be able to consider a flexible or diverse type skill base in which they're provided with the flexibility to transition from one industry to another. In effect, this might mean that a single trade or dual trade technical worker could be working on a solar farm one day and on a wind farm the next day. They might also work on a traditional power station later in the week. The ability for existing and new workers to find security and variety in their work offers tremendous economic opportunities for the region.

Transport and Logistics


The transport and logistics sector is a genuine strength of the Western Downs region. Significant road transport networks flow from east to west and from north to south. There is also an established and efficient transport corridor from the Port of Brisbane due to the Toowoomba Bypass. These transport corridors suit heavy vehicle operators for bulk commodities, freight haulage, fuels and special cargo.

Several specialist freight forwarders manage international delivery of parts to our region while equipment haulage companies and cranage companies deliver world class services for QOEMs. It is these companies that will be called upon to cart hundreds/thousands of wind farm components to the Wambo site including blades, turbine generators, tower segments, nacelles, cones and so on. Transport assessments and logistics are undertaken well in advance for moving long and heavy items such as wind turbine blades and tower components.

Environmental, Social and Corporate Governance (ESG) Opportunity: Environmental Social and Governance (ESG) creates a framework for project reporting on their companies or project footprint, but also assists in triple bottom line outcomes. 




